Recycling



These items can be placed in the Blue Box:

- **Plastic containers #1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, & 7 are accepted (no Styrofoam):**
 - remove lids, rinse & squash plastic containers
 - plastic grocery bags: nest all of one type into one bag
- **Glass bottles & jars including coloured glass only are accepted:**
 - remove lids, it is not necessary to remove labels
- **Aluminum and steel cans including clean aluminum pie plates are accepted:**

These items can be placed in the Blue Bag:

- Newspapers including flyers

These items can be placed in the Yellow Bag:

- **Mixed paper (phone books, magazines, office paper & envelopes)**
 - window envelopes are OK, staples OK
- **Boxboard (cereal boxes, tissue boxes)**
 - remove liners and flatten
- **Corrugated cardboard**
 - should be cut down to fit bag or flattened & tied into bundles (max 36"x24"x6")

DO NOT INCLUDE: waxed or foil paper, milk cartons or Tetra Paks

Garbage



Garbage must be stored in a place inaccessible to wildlife and placed at the curb after 5 am on Fridays:

- **Limit: 2 garbage cans per week to a maximum of 154 litres in total**
- **Excess garbage tags can be purchased at the Village Office for \$4 each**

Yard Trimmings



Yard trimmings collection starts on April 9 and continues to November

- **Yard trimmings includes leaves and green garden debris and small branches less than 3 feet long and 3 inches in diameter**
- **Yard trimmings must be placed in kraft paper bags, biodegradable plastic bags or garbage cans dedicated to hold only yard trimmings**
- **Branches should be tied in bundles**
- **Unlimited number of bags or cans permitted**
